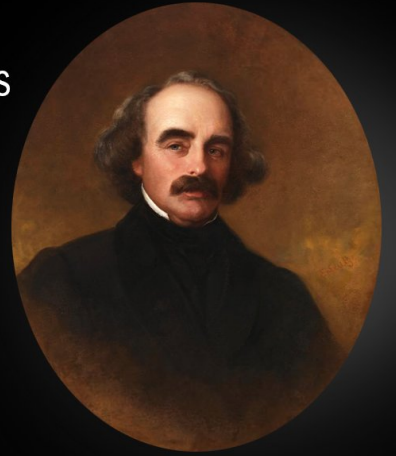
Learning Targets:
